



## **DISABLED PEOPLE**

The request for the free ticket needs to be sent to the email address <u>ticketing@milano2023.it</u>, a list with priority based on the date of receipt of the request will be created <u>Procedure:</u>

People declared 100% disabled (walking and non-ambulatory) can request a free ticket for a maximum of n. 2 sessions during the event (i.e.: daytime session in the Preliminary/Coloured Pists areas and afternoon session in the Finals Arena). The deadline for submitting the accreditation request is June 30, 2023.

The assignment will be based on the date of receipt of the request (subject to availability of seats). The interested person can also request a free ticket for an accompanying person.

If at 30 June, 2023 there are still vacancies in the dedicated sectors, interested people can be given free tickets for more than no. 2 sessions, always according to the chronological criterion of receipt of the requests and compatibly with the availability of places.

In order to receive a free ticket, it's mandatory to send an e-mail to <u>ticketing@milano2023.it</u> attaching the following documentation:

- Certificate of disability issued by the Local Health Authority, expressly indicating the percentage of disability;
- Valid identity document;
- Name of the companion (if present).

Once the documentation has been received, after checking the seat availability, the ticketing office will proceed to send the requested tickets from July 1, 2023.

In order to access the areas of the event, it will be necessary to present at the entrance:

- Ticket
- Valid ID
- Certificate of Disability

The ticket will not be transferable to third parties.

## **CHILDREN UNDER 4**

Children born after 31/12/2019 will be able to enter for free without a granted seat (the child must occupy the same seat as the parent).
